	fail to have at least over 2.5 overall 4.5, we are unable to provide
	the scholarship.
	* Since Spring semester 2015, this scholarship has not been
	provided during summer or winter vacations. However, if a
	student studies at UOS for a full academic year, UOS provides it
	during the vacation between the 2 semesters in case he/she stays
	in Korea more than 15 days per month.
