SCHEDULES

The program will run one poster session onsite as well as parallel oral presentations sessions. Online sessions via Tencent Meeting will be available for participants who are located outside of the Chinese Mainland.

Poster Presentation Session

All posters will be displayed in the Central Building during the event. The Poster Presentation will be held onsite on the morning of 15th December.

Oral Presentation Sessions

Each oral presentation has a 15-minute slot, including 5 minutes for Q&A. Oral presentations will be grouped by the disciplinary areas for morning or afternoon sessions.

ELIGIBILITY

- Currently registered PhD students of Year 2 or above who are able to present their research in English
- The presented research falls into one of the following disciplines: Electrical and Electronic Engineering; Computer Science and Software Engineering; Business; Public Health; Environmental Science; Mathematical Sciences; Biological Sciences; Chemistry; Urban Planning and Design; Civil Engineering; Industrial Design; Architecture; English, Culture and Communication; China Studies; International Relations; Education

REGISTRATION AND SUBMISSION

Due to limited availability of places, applicants must register and submit their papers and posters to the symposium by the deadlines set out below.

Students will be informed of the decision whether they are selected to be presenting in the symposium by 22 November, 2022.

FEES AND EXPENSES

There is no registration fee. Applicants who are selected to join the onsite event but not based at Suzhou will be provided accommodation for no more than two nights.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstract submission:

At the time of registration, you should submit an abstract of no more than 100 words.

Poster submission:

The poster could be either a research focused poster which disseminates selected aspects of your research project, or a public dissemination poster which provides an introduction to the wider research field in which your research is based.

Your poster must be in A0 portrait format (80cm*120cm), and should include

- 1) Paper/research title and all authors
- 2) Summary of main research problem/question, aims and objectives of the project, methodology, key findings and practical implication of the study
- 3) References

The most successful posters are graphically rich presentations of your research that highlight and summarize the main points, using clear and concise language, without jargon, to reach the widest possible audience inside or outside of your discipline.

Paper submission:

To apply for presenting in the oral presentation sessions, you should submit an extended abstract of your research. The extended abstract should not exceed 2 single-spaced pages (excluding references and tables) and include the following:

- 1) A description of your study, including research questions and aims, methodology and key findings, and practical implications of the study
- 2) Supporting material: references, tables and figures that support the research.
